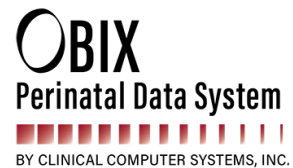

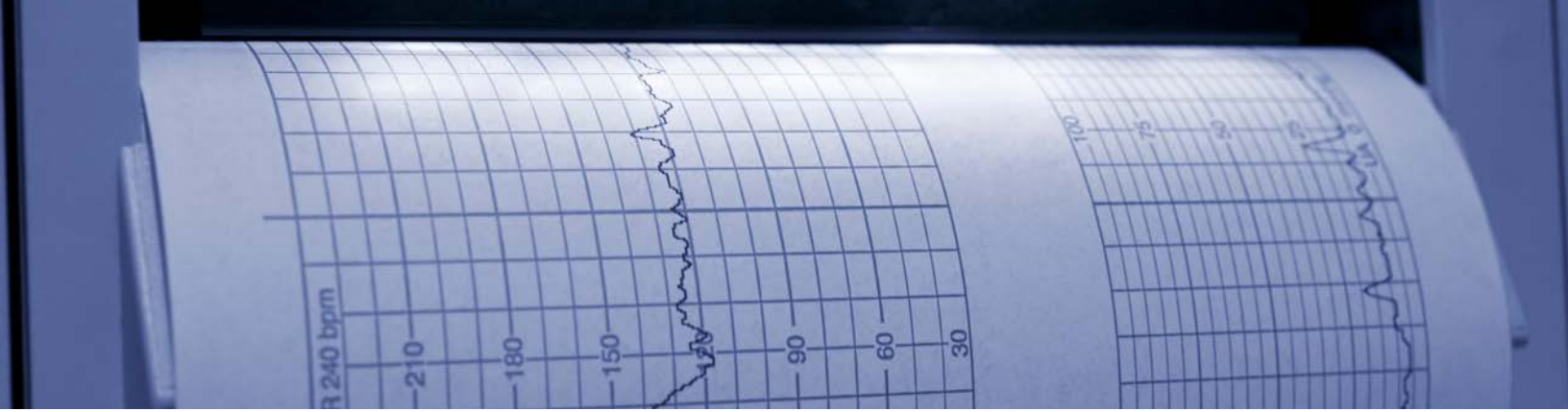
Grapefruit Citrus Sparkler, 1 drink

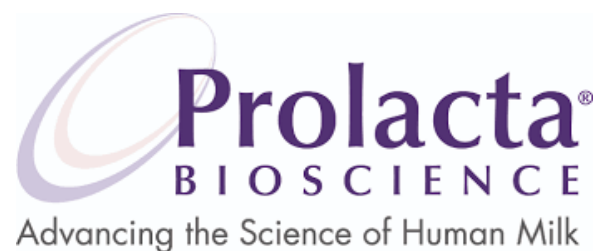
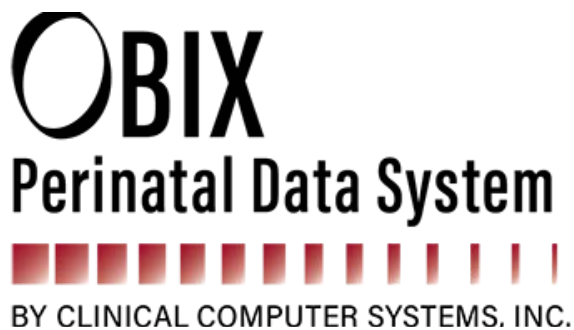
